Cyhalofop Butyl Conditions

General Conditions:

- 1. A permit must be obtained from the Sacramento County Agricultural Commissioner prior to any use of Cyhalofop Butyl in Sacramento County.
- 2. A Notice of Intent (NOI) is required for all applications of Cyhalofop Butyl and shall be filed at least 24 hours before the application and at least 48 hours on weekends/holidays, unless specifically approved by the Sacramento County Agricultural Commissioner's Office.
- 3. As provided in Title 3, Food and Agriculture Code, California Code of Regulations, Section 6444, the Sacramento County Agricultural Commissioner may suspend any Cyhalofop Butyl applications in any part of the county if symptoms of Cyhalofop Butyl appear on peaches/nectarines, or other sensitive crops (any crop other than rice).
- 4. Follow all directions and use precautions of the agriculturally approved crop oil concentrate used in the Cyhalofop Butyl application. No other material may be used in the mix solution.
- 5. All pest Control Operators (PCOs), Planes, Pilots and Private Applicators must be annually certified through an approved stewardship program prior to making an application of Cyhalofop Butyl.
- 6. Read and follow the registered labeling for any additional requirements.

Ground Applications:

- 1. All applications of Cyhalofop Butyl shall be made with a minimum wind speed of 3 mph to a maximum wind speed of 10 mph. *The maximum wind speed will be strictly enforced.* Wind measurements shall be made 4 feet above the crop being treated.
- 2. No ground application of Cyhalofop Butyl shall be made within 660 feet of any commercial peach or nectarine orchards.

- 3. Ground application of Cyhalofop Butyl between 660 feet and 1320 feet from commercial peach or nectarine orchards shall be made with a wind of at least 3 mph and in a direction away from those orchards.
- 4. No applications of Cyhalofop Butyl shall be made within 50 feet of any nontarget cereal or grass crops.

Aerial Applications:

- 1. Apply using fixed-wing aircraft only.
- 2. Spray booms must be fitted with a flat fan 4015 spray tip, unless the Cyhalofop Butyl label allows otherwise, set at 0 degrees deflection.
- 3. Minimum wind restriction is 3 mph and maximum wind restriction is 7 mph, measured at 4 feet above the crop canopy.
- 4. Maximum application height above the crop canopy is 10 feet.
- 5. Do not apply when the temperature is greater than 85 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 6. No aerial applications are allowed in Sacramento County with north winds.

6444. Generalized Effects.

If at any time pesticide residues, symptoms, or health hazards appear generally throughout any area, the director or commissioner may cause a field inspection to be made. If it appears that substantial loss, damage or injury is likely to result from continued application of a specific pesticide within such area, the director or commissioner may cause all permits for applications of that pesticide within such area canceled and specify that no additional permits shall be issued therein.
