

Aerial Phenoxy Conditions on Rice

- No phenoxy herbicides shall be applied by fixed or rotary winged aircraft in Sacramento County within five (5) miles of cotton plantings.
- Not more than 500 acres may be treated by air each day.
- Each Notice of Intent for aerial application of phenoxy herbicides must be approved by the Sacramento County Agricultural Commissioner's Office prior to application.
- There must be a positive steady wind flow (at least 2 mph and not more than 7 mph) away from all cotton plantings within a twenty-five (25) mile radius of the application site.
- Use of drift control agent is required if recommended by manufacturer of the herbicide.
- Nozzle requirements must be consistent with Title 3CCR Section 6460.
- No applications may be made in inversion conditions smoke column required throughout application to assure proper monitoring of conditions.
- No applications may be made at greater than 10 feet above the target crop.
- Any applications planned for Sunday or Monday must have a NOI submitted by 3 p.m. on the preceding Friday.
